Executive Order No. 401.

MILITARY GOVERNMENT OF SANTO DOMINGO.

Executive Order No. 402.

WHEREAS, the Comunes of the Dominican Republic are in need of additional revenue, and

WHEREAS, the disbursement of all funds supplied from the NATIONAL TREASURY should be effectively supervised,

By virtue of the powers vested in the MILITARY GOVERNMENT of Santo Domingo, the following EXECUTIVE ORDER is hereby promulgated:

Art. 1. There shall be set aside annually from funds not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$250,000 in addition to the otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$250,000 in addition to the apportioned and paid to the several comunas; PROVIDED, that for the year 1920 the appropriation under this Article shall be \$187,500.

Art. 2. The allotment to each Comuna from the said sum of \$250,000 shall bear the same proportion to that amount as the collection of the tax on Patentes in that Comuna for the preceding calendar year bears to the total collection of the tax on Patentes in the Republic for the same year.
