Executive Order No. 522.

Title: Funds for Engraving and Printing
maps of the Dominican Republic
prepared by U. S. Geological Survey.

By virtue of the powers vested in the Military Government of Santo Domingo, the following Order is hereby dictated and promulgated:

There is hereby appropriated from funds in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) to cover cost of engraving and printing maps of the Dominican Republic prepared by the United States Geological Survey.

Executive Order No. 527.

Law to govern Guardas Campestres.

By virtue of the powers vested in the Military Government of Santo Domingo the following Executive Order is dictated and promulgated:

ARTICLE 1. The Law of Congress governing Guardas Campestres, dated June 26. 1907, and published in the Official Gazette No. 1957 of December 30, 1908, is hereby repealed.

ARTICLE 2.—Each land owner and any person who holds a right of usufruct, use, or benefit over a parcel of land may employ a Guarda Campestre to serve as watchman on his property.
