Executive Order No. 532.

Title: Amendment to E. O. No. 256 authorizing
the establishment of a Leper Colony.

By virtue of the powers vested in the Military Government of Santo Domingo, the following amendment to Executive Order 256 establishing the National Leper Colony is hereby dictated and promulgated:

The sum appropriated for expenses in connection with the establishment of the National Leper Colony is hereby increased from EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000) to ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$127,000) and the additional amount of FORTY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$47,000) is hereby appropriated from funds, not otherwise appropriated, in the National Treasury.

Title: Appropriation for one four-
room school house at Samana.

By virtue of the powers vested in the Military Government of Santo Domingo and upon recommendation of the Secretaría de Justicia y Instrucción Pública, the following Order is hereby dictated and promulgated:

There is hereby appropriated from the account "Public Instruction Funds for 1919" established by Executive Order No. 413, the sum of FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) for the erection of a four-room school house in Samaná.
